The International Conference on Bioinformatics (InCoB) is the official conference of the Asia-Pacific Bioinformatics Network (<u>APBioNet</u>). InCoB showcases the latest research and technologies in all areas of bioinformatics and is attended by practitioners from both biology and computing backgrounds in the Asia-Pacific region.

InCoB2010 (<a href="http://incob10.hgc.jp">http://incob10.hgc.jp</a>) convenes at Waseda University International Conference Center, Tokyo and is organized in collaboration with the International Immunomics Society (<a href="IIMMS">IIMMS</a>), Chem-Bio Informatics Society (<a href="CBI">CBI</a>) and supported by the Japanese Society for Bioinformatics (<a href="ISBI">ISBI</a>). Highlights include synthetic genomes and organisms, systems drug discovery, and robotics assisted pathogen identification. Clyde A. Hutchison III (J.
