The International Conference on Bioinformatics (InCoB) is the official conference of the Asia-Pacific Bioinformatics Network (APBioNet). InCoB showcases the latest research and technologies in all areas of bioinformatics and is attended by practitioners from both biology and computing backgrounds in the Asia-Pacific region.

InCoB2010 (<http://incob10.hgc.jp>) convenes at Waseda University International Conference Center, Tokyo and is organized in collaboration with the International Immunomics Society (IIMMS), Chem-Bio Informatics Society (CBI) and supported by the Japanese Society for Bioinformatics (JSBi). Highlights include synthetic genomes and organisms, systems drug discovery, and robotics assisted pathogen identification. Clyde A. Hutchison III (J. Craig Venter Institute), Hiroaki Kitano (The Systems Biology Institute), and Yoshiyuki Nagai (RIKEN CRNIID) are Keynote Speakers. On September 28, CBI organizes sessions on synthetic biology, translational bioinformatics, cloud computing in bioinformatics, molecular robotics and biocomputing. IIMMS will held on the last day the 3<sup>rd</sup> Conference of Basic and Clinical Immunogenomics and Immunomics (BCII).
